Facts I will learn


- The United Kingdom is made up of four countries.
- The United Kingdom is surrounded by four seas.
- Each country has a capital city.
- Different areas have different physical features such as beaches, cliffs, coasts, forests, hills, mountains, seas, oceans, rivers, valleys and vegetation.
- Human features consist of cities, towns, villages, factories, farms, houses, offices, ports, harbours and shops.
- We live in the North West of England.
