Facts I will learn - Blackpool is located on the North West coast of England. - The seafront consists of a 7-mile sandy beach, with a flat coastline in the south of the district. - Blackpool has three piers, the North (built in 1863), Central (1868) and South (1893). - Blackpool Tower, built in May 1894, is a 518-foot-tall copy of the Eiffel Tower. - Blackpool has, like all of the UK, a temperate maritime climate. - Coasts are changed by nature and humans. Changes can be caused as the sea erodes the land. Because of these changes, coasts have many different features, such as beaches, cliffs, islands and caves. 	Key questions - Where is Blackpool located and why is it popular destination? - What physical and human features are there in Blackpool? - How does Blackpool compare with other places/towns that we know about? - What other towns in the UK might be similar to Blackpool? - What is the weather like in Blackpool? What is the best time of year to visit? - How does Blackpool compare to Burnley?
