Dear Parents/Carers

We are delighted to announce that from September 2022, we will be introducing the positions of Head Boy and Girl, as well as a Deputy for each, at Brunshaw Primary School. These positions are being exclusively offered to our new Year 6 children (current Year 5).

We believe that nurturing good pupil leaders is an important element to our school's success. We want children to be encouraged to develop the skills to enable them to take responsibility for their school and then to contribute positively, both to the school and wider community. Together, they will work to improve the school and suggest solutions to various dilemmas. They will play a vital role in the life of the school and will be the pupils' "public face." They will be required to speak to groups of parents, children and teachers (with support). Other key responsibilities will include things such as:

- Welcoming visitors to school and showing them around
- Making presentations/helping in assemblies
- Supporting younger children in school
- Welcoming parents to Parents Evening/New Parents Meetings

It is vital that the chosen children upkeep the high expectations of Brunshaw, as they will be role models to their fellow pupils. There will be an expectation that the chosen candidates always come to school in full and correct school uniform. Due to our high expectations of the selected pupils, the role of Head or Deputy could be transferred to a fellow applicant, at any point in the year, if standards are consistently unacceptable.

Children are invited to complete an application letter (template attached) explaining why they feel they would be suited to the role of Head or Deputy Boy/Girl. The closing date for the applications is Tuesday 5th July, so please support your child in completing their letter at home. The letters will then be shared with pupils and staff, who will anonymously vote for their future representatives. The successful candidates will be announced in our end of year Celebration Assembly on Thursday 21st July.
