2. School Uniform

In case any of you are starting to get uniforms ready for September, just a reminder of our uniform policy:

- White polo shirt (with or without school logo)
- Royal blue sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo (**no hoodies**)
- Grey skirt or pinafore
- Grey trousers or shorts (**NOT LEGGINGS**)
- Plain grey, black or white socks/tights
- Plain black shoes (**NO TRAINERS**) (no laces in Reception and Year 1 please)
- Optional summer uniform – blue and white gingham dress

2. School Uniform (continued)

Accessories

- Hair long enough to be tied back must be tied back with a plain bobble or plain headband (no bows)
- Earrings must be studs (on PE days these must be removed)
- Blue reading bags with the school logo or a small flat bag for carrying reading books

From September all children must attend school every day in full school uniform. On PE days, children are to bring their kits in a drawstring PE bag, which must be plain blue or black. This will remain in school and will be sent home at the end of each half term to be washed.

For your information PE kit details are as follows:

Indoor PE (RECEPTION TO YEAR 6)

- Black/blue shorts
- White, round-neck t-shirt, with or without the school badge
- Black pumps

Outdoor PE (YEARS 1-6 ONLY)

- Black/blue shorts or joggers (weather-dependant)
- White, round-neck t-shirt, with or without the school badge
- Black/blue tracksuit top during colder weather
- Trainers

Basic PE kit is available from any of the leading supermarkets including Asda and Tesco. For kit featuring the school badge, we recommend Moonline on Standish Street.

All items must have your child's name in. Earrings must be studs and these must be removed on PE days.
