## Strike Action – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023

Dear Parent/Carer,

As you will be aware, the National Education Union (NEU), in accordance with the provisions of the Trade Union and Labour Relations Act 1992, are calling upon their members to strike. The proposed industrial action will take place on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

To determine if there will be the need for a full or partial closure on some or all of these days, we have undertaken a Risk Assessment and I am writing to confirm our arrangements for Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

If you are classed as a critical worker, and despite your best efforts to organise alternative provision for your child, you will experience childcare issues on Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2023, please contact the school office to see if any extraordinary provision can be provided.

We appreciate that industrial action is disruptive, and you may need to change your plans or working arrangements, whilst this action is ongoing. We will, of course, continue to monitor the arrangements in place and make modifications to improve support for students, wherever possible. However, ensuring the health and safety of our students must take priority.
