To ensure that children receive opportunities to learn a variety of musical instruments. To allow the children the opportunity to perform to different audiences during their time at Brunshaw. To design a curriculum which develops both knowledge of skills and music, including musicians and how it has changed throughout history. To build upon key vocabulary and progression of knowledge and skills as the children move up through school. To continue to monitor, reflect and update the music curriculum ensuring that both staff and children have a range of experiences to improve and broaden their knowledge, understanding and skills.	To continue to support staff subject knowledge to ensure that a good music curriculum is being taught consistently through school. To plan regular CPD and use staff meetings to review the music coverage within school, developing staff knowledge and understanding. To ensure that lessons are planned with the support of the knowledge organisers and sequencing documents, as well as completing and evidencing formative and summative assessments for each unit of work. To ensure children progress and gain musical knowledge which is shown within the work they produce. To work with Music Practitioners employed by school to ensure that the children are receiving the best provision.	For children to understand the relevance of what they are learning within school, linking it to the wider world and their place in it. To enjoy the musical experiences at their time at Brunshaw. To ensure that the children experience watching performances as well as performing to others in order to develop their confidence. To continue to check music data and curriculum coverage to best support children's learning and progression as well as staff's knowledge and skills. To conduct pupil interviews three times annually with the music ambassadors to ensure that their voice is heard in regards to the curriculum.

To ensure that staff's subject knowledge is strong in order to inspire children. To offer extra curricular music clubs to enhance children's experiences and passion. To offer key roles to music ambassadors to enhance the love for music and inspire others. To develop and monitor the use of knowledge organisers and a personalised curriculum which reflects our children's needs.	To ensure that the curriculum is well resourced, offering a wide range of instruments. To involve music ambassadors within the monitoring of the music curriculum and the delivery of whole school knowledge in assemblies. To ensure that musical clubs are offered to a variety of children. To continue to liaise with Lancashire Music Service to ensure good quality teaching is consistent and any feedback is acted upon.	
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
