1 Shared Human Experience	To know a family is a group of two or more persons related by birth, marriage, or adoption who live together To understand a family brings you back to your values and helps you make good decisions. A family is whoever you can depend on for support, to laugh with, to play with, and to share the challenges and rewards of life with. Family means having someone to love you unconditionally in spite of you and your shortcomings. To know some of the more common variations in traditional family structure include single-parent families, step families, extended families, and same-sex families To understand that Family members can be related by birth, marriage, adoption, or foster care. Your immediate family includes parents, siblings, spouse, and children. And your extended family includes people you are related to, such as grandparents, cousins, aunts & uncles, nephews, nieces, in-laws, stepfamily, etc	What do we mean by family? 	To know we show appreciation and affection. Appreciation and affection are about caring for each other as family members. Sharing positive emotional feelings with each other and being nice to each other are just a couple of ways families show appreciation and affection. To know that we have other groups we belong to - e.g. school, class, clubs, religions and that these groups are like families too as we share some of the same feelings as we do to our own families.		
2 Beliefs and Values	To understand a baptism is a Christian sacrament (rite), where people are welcomed into the family of God To know that Christian parents baptise their children as Baptism declares that you are a follower of Jesus Christ. It is a public confession of your faith in, and commitment to, Jesus Christ. It is the next step after salvation through repentance and faith and is an important foundation for Christian life Christians believe that the Church community is like a family. Remind children that they have previously found out that Christians think of God as being like a father <i>In some Christian communities, parents ask for their child to be baptised so that it can belong to this family and can develop a relationship with God.</i> They believe that this will mean the baby will grow up with the support of the Church family as well as their own family.	• Why is it important to welcome new members into the Church family? 	In the infant baptism ceremony, the parents will also say thank you to God for the gift of their child. Christians celebrate birth by welcoming babies into the church.		
3 Living Religious Traditions	To know that the baby's family and friends all go to a church service, where a priest or the vicar will read something from the Bible. The vicar will perform several rituals, after which special prayers will be said for the baby. The baby's parents and godparents also pledge (promise) to bring the baby up in the Christian faith To know that the cross that is made on a baby's head in the context of welcoming a child into the family of God in the church. It symbolises the mark of Christians showing that Jesus died on the Cross for us. At baptism parents and grandparents trace it on the child's forehead to show that the child belongs to Christ, who now offers his help and grace always to face and overcome the sufferings and trials that life may throw at us To understand that through baptism Christians become members of God's family, a son or daughter of the Father. They belong to God for all eternity. As a consequence, they also belong to the family of God here on earth – brothers and sisters in Christ	How might some people show they belong to God?
