On seeing Solomon and his army,  a namlah (female ant) warned all the others to "get into your habitations, lest Solomon and his hosts crush you (under foot) without knowing it." Immediately understanding what the ant said, Solomon, as always, prayed to God, thanking him for bestowing upon him such gifts and further avoided trampling over the ant colonies.  The Crying Camel – The camel tied up was hot and thirsty. Muhammed (PBUH) told the owner to look after his camel as the camel carries him and it is one of Gods creations  To know that Muhammed (PBUH) is a good role model for Muslims as he used to pay attention to his people and appreciate them. He was very compassionate, loving and merciful to his companions. He would console them in times of sorrow, visit them to ask about their conditions and teach them good manners and ethics.
