

Home School Agreement

The School will endeavour to: -

- Provide the highest standard of education for all pupils, within a caring, calm and formal/informal environment.
- Assess your child regularly in school to tailor learning to their needs.
- Inform you of your child's progress through Parents' Evening and reports.
- Provide term dates and start/finish times of the school day.
- Recognise and reward good attendance and punctuality.
- Contact you if there is a problem with attendance and punctuality – on a daily, weekly or half-termly basis.
- Have clear expectations and policies for behaviour, which pupils and families know and understand, and can follow.
- Make clear that the school rejects bullying of any kind, physical violence and destructive behaviour.
- Recognise and reward good behaviour.
- Provide, mark and celebrate homework on a regular basis, as appropriate.
- Keep you informed about school life through the website Dojo, newsletters, social media and text messaging service.
- Inform you about serious incidents/accidents involving your child. (Either by face to face meeting, text, or telephone call).



As a Pupil I will: -

- Work hard and achieve my best with all class work and homework.
- Go to bed early enough each night so that I am ready to learn every day.
- Aim for attendance above 96%.
- Follow the school's behaviour expectations and policies.
- Take pride in appearance and wear correct school uniform at all times (includes P.E. kit).
- Complete homework to my best standard and hand in on time.

As a Parent, I will: -

- Support the school's aims and policies, including school uniform.
- Ensure my child has plenty of quality sleep every night before school so they are ready to learn.
- Provide my child with a nutritious breakfast before school each day and encourage them to understand why eating a healthy breakfast is important for learning.
- Work with the school to make use of the breakfast club facility if I am not able to provide my child with a nutritious breakfast.
- Ensure my child attends school regularly and on time – aiming for at least 96% attendance.
- Notify school promptly in line with policy of illness or any reasons for absence from school.
- Work with the school to improve attendance where it is below 96%
- Not take holidays during term time.
- Encourage my child to behave well and follow schools behaviour expectations and policies.
- Help my child see the importance and value of homework.
- Listen to my child read every day.
- Help my child learn their spellings to the best of their ability.
- Help my child to learn their times tables to the best of their ability
- Inform school of accurate personal details of my child including up to date contact numbers and medical information.
- Read the weekly newsletter (also available on the school website).
