To know that Edvard Grieg was a Norweigen Romantic composer who wrote Romantic pieces often describing a story or a place. To know that composers poured emotion, energy and passion into their pieces. Some expressed love and some expressed tragedy. It didn't always start in the key that it started in. To know that a musical drone is an accompaniment where a note or chord is continuously sounded throughout most or all of a piece.
