Subject: RE	Year group: 1 Term: Autumn 1	Title: How might some people show that they 'belong' to God? Key Question (to be used all year): What do people say about God?
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What should I already know? - Christians believe in the church as the family of god. - Family comes in different shapes and sizes. - The role of a priest. - What an alter is. - What a church is and who worships there.	Facts I will learn: - To know that some Christians welcome babies into the God’s family (the Church) with baptism ceremonies. - Christians believe that the Church community is like a family. - Christians think of God as being like a father.	Key questions: - What do we mean by family? - Why is it important to welcome new members into the Church family? - How might some people show they belong to God? - What is my role within the family?
Key Skills: - talk about what it might mean to belong to the Church family - talk about why parents might want to have their child baptised - identify features of baptism – eg. the font, candles, godparents - talk about their own identity as part of a family and part of the school community - talk about what is means to belong to a family	Experiences that school will provide: Visit St Catherine’s and recreate a baptism.
