Facts I will learn

Key questions-

- What is trust? What makes someone trustworthy?
- How did Noah put his trust in God?
- What is the festival of Sukkot and how is this a time when the Jews thank God for looking after them?
- Is it important to keep promises?



Key Skills-

- Give examples of a key belief e.g. the story of Noah
- Give examples of a core value or commitment
- Use religious words and phrases to recognise and name features of religious traditions
- Talk about the way that religious beliefs might be influence the way a person behaves
- Notice and show curiosity about people and how they live their lives
- Understand that trust is an important part of life
- Ask questions about the importance of trust

Experiences that school will provide:

- Circle time- the children, together, will create a class list of agreed promises and decorate it with fingerprints as signatures.
- Retelling the story of Noah's Ark.

promise	a statement that something absolutely will happen or be done.
Sukkot	A Jewish festival.
Sukkah	A traditional Jewish structure, created during the Sukkot holiday. A hut.
Judaism	The religion of the Jewish people.
