<p><b>What should I already know?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Builds on prior knowledge about how Christians are guided to live their lives.</li><li>• Children will be familiar with some bible stories about Jesus.</li><li>• Different aspects of the Christian church.</li><li>• know that some Christians welcome babies into the God’s family with baptism ceremonies.</li></ul>	<p><b>Facts I will learn:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• That some people believe we go to heaven, we are reincarnated or nothing happens etc.</li><li>• the effect that belief in salvation brought about by Jesus’ death and resurrection has.</li><li>• discover how the act of confessing sins and seeking reconciliation and forgiveness restores relationships with others and with God in the eyes of the believer, leading to faith in life after death.</li><li>• That there are many rewards for forgiveness and bible stories help to show this</li><li>• That the purpose of life is different for people – family, happiness, building a home, wealth, career etc...</li></ul>	<p><b>Key questions:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What beliefs and ideas do people have about what happens after death?</li><li>• What do Christian believe about death and resurrection?</li><li>• Why do Christians believe about forgiveness and sins?</li><li>• What do Christian teachings tell us about forgiveness and what are the benefits and difficulties of forgiveness?</li><li>• What is the meaning or purpose of life?</li></ul>
