What should I already know?  - Why Muslims must act and dress modestly (reception) - Muslims believe that bodies are special gifts given to them by Allah (reception) - Muslims believe in one God- Allah (Y1) - Islam teaches us that humans have a special role to be caretakers of the planet (Y1) - Obedience is a way of showing gratitude to God (year 2) - Why prayer is important to Muslims (year 2)  	Facts I will learn - A role model is a person who is looked up to in society as a good example. - Muhammed is a prophet sent by God (Allah) to bring his message to the world. - Muhammed was chosen to spread the word of God. He was an example of how to behave. - Allah sent the message through the prophets to be charitable. All Muslims give money to charity. - Role models behave in a way that other people should follow.	Key questions - What makes a person a good role model? - Who is the prophet Muhammad? - Why is the prophet Muhammad an example for Muslims? - Why is being charitable important to Muslims? - How can I be a good role model?
