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What should I already know? • To understand that Jesus is the Son of God. • To know why Christians say that Jesus is a special baby. • To identify aspects of Christmas celebrations. • To identify different characters in the nativity.	Facts I will learn: • To know light helps us to see in the dark, grow food and help us live • To know that Jesus helps us to see God, and he sheds truth on what is true and righteous - that Jesus has different titles- Christ/Messiah/Saviour/Song of God. • To understand Christians use light as part of the Christmas celebrations as 'Jesus is the LIGHT of the world' and is a time of helping others less fortunate • To know that Christingles are oranges wrapped in red tape, decorated with dried fruit or sweets, with a candle on the top – they represent a symbol of advent • To know that light is provided to keep them safe – through adults who care for them	Key questions: • How do humans use light and why is it important? • Why do Christians say that Jesus is the 'Light of the World'? • How do Christians use light as part of their Christmas celebrations? • What is a Christingle and what does it represent? • Who brings light into my life?
