What should I already know?

Key questions:

- What is significance and how does a person become significant?
- What was the Trinity Cross?
- Who was Learie Constantine and what is he remembered for?
- How did Learie Constantine adjust to life in Lancashire/ England?
- Did Learie Constantine make peoples' lives better?
- Who is Learie Constantine and why is he so significant?

- Children will be able to discuss the lives of significant individuals in the past who have contributed to national and international achievements whilst understanding the reasons
- for their significance.
- Children will be able to discuss the lives of significant historical people in the pupils' own locality.
- Children will be able to ask and answer questions about the past through observing a range of sources such as objects/ pictures.
- Children will be able to identify some similarities and differences between ways of life at different times.
- Children will be able to use sources to answer simple questions about the past.
- Children will be able to recognise some of the reasons why people in the past acted as they did.
